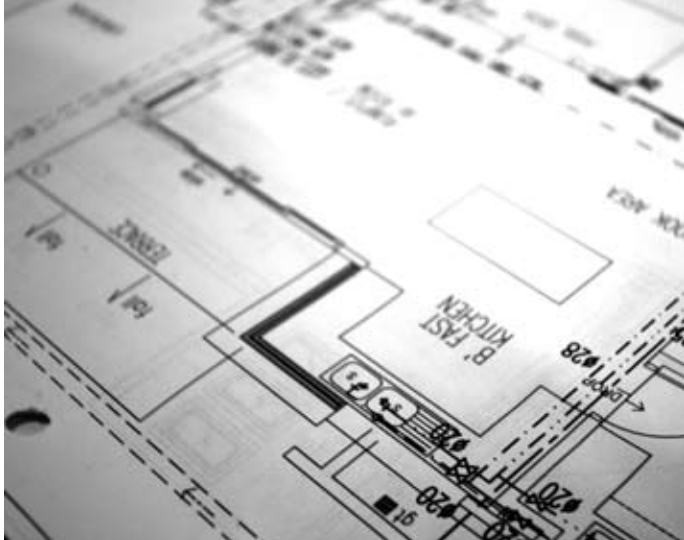




Waterscape

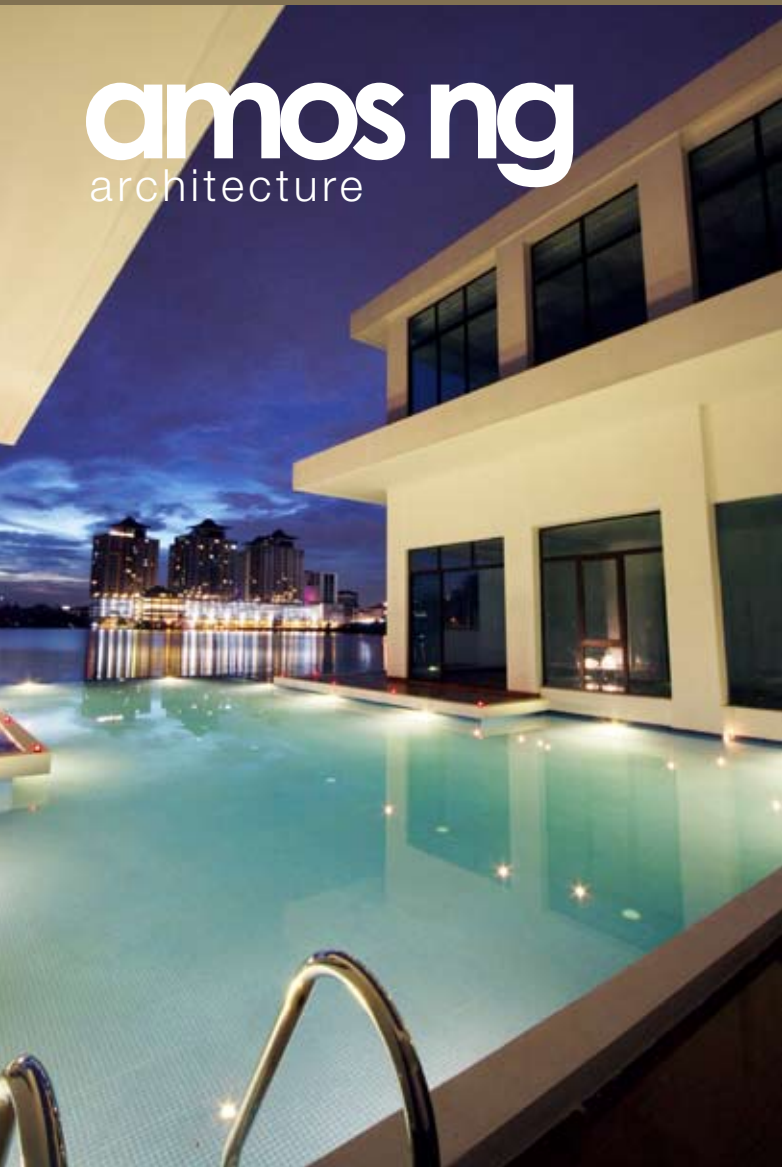
